On Saturday 17th June, eight Members of Redruth Judo Club travelled to Cardiff to take part in a National Level Charity Judo Tournament, with six being successful in their fights.



Ollie Jehu, Tecca Ford, Jamie Collick and future Redruth School student Izzy Ninnis were all competing in a new age band category. A highlight of the tournament was Rosie Ninnis and Tecca fighting for the top place in the same weight category and it could have gone either way, but Rosie took Tecca with an Ippon throw to win the group in the last 45 seconds of the fight!

Jago Ford was competing against brown and black belts in the Cadet category and was knocked out in the 3rd round leaving him in 6th place in the Cadet ranking. He then competed in the Senior group 14yrs - 21yrs and after some excellent Judo earned a Bronze Medal. Great experience for him as this was his first time in competitions as a Senior.

The Redruth Club in total took 8 players and 8 medals were won, 2 Gold, 2 Silver and 4 Bronze medals.
