STEM Conference - University of Exeter

The most talented scientists from local primary schools were invited to take part in the second Redruth School Year 6 More Able STEM conference, held in association with the University of Exeter. The focus of the conference was to look at the impact of human activity on the environment and how new technologies are able to reduce the effects of global warming.

Pupils were encouraged to be innovative in designing systems to provide green energy for city environments.

Lecturers and students from the Penryn Campus of the University of Exeter helped pupils focus upon reducing carbon footprint, how solar cells can be used to generate green energy and their limitations and creating the best design for a wind turbine.

The Year 6 delegates left the conference having had a fantastic time and learnt more about the sustainability of our energy supplies.
