Redruth swimmers, Turaya Evans and Charlie Varker have splashed their names across the county record books, competing in the annual Cornwall County Swimming Championships over 2 weekends in Bodmin and Penzance.

Year 10 student, Turaya Evans took a huge haul of trophies, winning the County Junior Championship events in 50m, 100m and 200m Backstroke; 50m, 100m and 200m Front crawl and 100m Individual Medley. In doing so Turaya has set 5 new County Records.



Year 9 student, Charlie Varker bagged himself 6 Junior County final wins in the 50m and 100m Front crawl, 50m, 100m and 200 Backstroke and 100m Individual Medley with 4 new County records and a swag of other medals too.



Both Turaya and Charlie have now set up promising seasons ahead, with Turaya competing at the next British Championships in Edinburgh and Charlie in the South West regionals in May 2018.
