Little Princess Trust

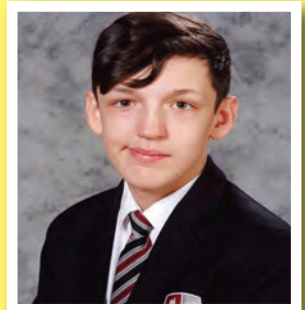
