School Praised for Excellent Relationships, Community Involvement, Polite and Friendly Pupils and GCSE Attainment



An inspection of Redruth School has taken place by Ofsted. A team of 5 inspectors over 2 days looked at all aspects of the school and judged the school to be 'Good' with many strengths. The report identifies the work done by staff, governors and the leadership team where "the headteacher's vision of high achievement for all pupils is understood by the whole school community", and where "governors are committed to raising the aspiration and achievement of pupils in the local area". "Pupils' respectful relationships with teachers make a significant contribution to their learning" and where the students are "proud to belong to this school". The Parent survey found that "many parents commented about the positive relationships teachers have with pupils", and that "parents believe the pupils are well taught.
