Samuel also entered the Brass Solo Open and came first!

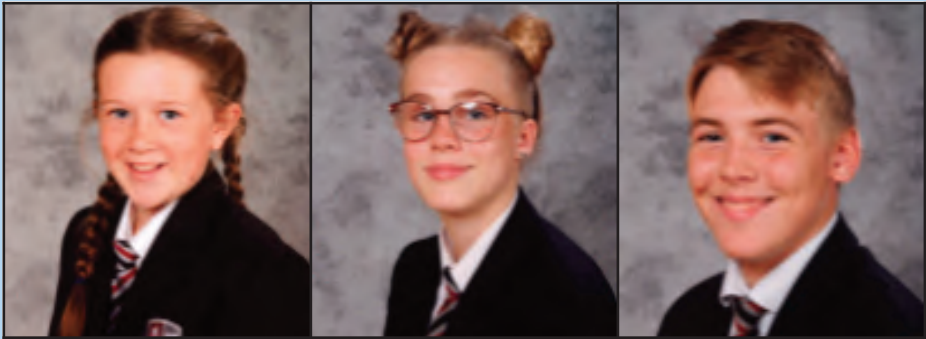


# Judo Cornish Champions
